ARTICULATION CARD

- **Due date for all On-Line submissions is: February 21 at midnight**
- **Make informed decisions in choosing classes: talk to your current teachers, as well as juniors & teachers who instruct classes you are interested in taking next year.**
- **You should not ask your teachers for written recommendations. They have already submitted their recommendations to counseling.**
- **Read the Course Descriptions found on the counseling website (srhscounseling.com) under Academics.**
- **Look at teachers' websites for more information about specific classes.**
- **Remember that grades from 1st semester, teacher recommendations and end-of-course exam scores (if available) are used for placement.**
- **READ THE PREREQUISITES! If you do not meet them, you will be removed from the course.**
- **You will notice that the classes are listed in order of the UC A-G requirements. It is important to be aware of each of the categories.**
- **Go to your Student Portal on PowerSchool and choose Class Registration found on the left side of the page. Follow directions and select your courses. Hit SUBMIT when done.**
- **Please complete the the Elective Choice Google Form on the Sophomore page for "back-up" electives. You should indicate at least 4 courses as back-up options.**

University of California Areas A-E

- **Area A- History/Social Sciences**
 - World History goes to US History. Only those with A's in Regular World History **and** English **with** teacher recommendation may select Honors.
 - Advanced World History:
 - C grade, goes to US History.
 - B or A, goes to Honors US History
 - A in Adv. World History **and** Adv English: or an A or B in AP Euro, may choose AP US History.
- **Area B – English**
 - English 3-4 goes to American Literature. An A grade in English 3 **with** teacher recommendation may choose Honors Am. Lit.
 - Adv English 3:
 - C goes to Am Lit.
 - A or B may choose Honors Am. Lit.
 - B may choose AP English Language **with** teacher recommendation.
 - A may select AP Eng. Lang.
- **Area C - Math**
 - ALL Juniors will take math!
 - Take the next class in progressive order.
 - **End of year grades and score on end of year exam (if available) will dictate your class for next year.**
 - **Math teachers are making recommendations for each student in the spring.**
- **Area D - Science**

ALL students must have physics, biology and chemistry.

 - Biology to Chemistry.
 - A grade of **A in Biology with AIM and teacher recommendation** may take Honors Chemistry.
 - Advanced Bio:
 - A or B to Honors Chemistry with concurrent enrollment in Advanced Inetgrated Math.
 - A with teacher recommendation and completion of AIM 3 may go to AP Chemistry.

- C to Chemistry.
- AP Bio:
 - A to Honors or AP Chemistry
 - B goes to Honors Chem or AP Chem with with teacher recommendation
 - C to Honors Chem.
- **Area E - Language Other Than English (LOTE)**
 - Minimum of 2 years (same language) are required for graduation and college entry, 3+ recommended for UC and some private schools.

Areas F, G and Other Electives

****Select at least 6 courses across areas F, G or Other Electives. Indicate your top choices on your Class Registration**

The **BOLD** type on the articulation card signifies a Pathway Course. If you take Intermediate Course in 11th grade, you must commit to taking the Advanced Course in 12th grade.

- **Area F - VAPA...** Make sure you have taken a VAPA (1 year required). If not by junior year then you must take in senior year.
- **Area G - College Prep Elective and Electives.** ONLY 1 year of an Area G course is needed for college entry. All of the following meet the G elective requirement for college entry: Math higher than Integrated Math III, 3rd year of Science, certain classes (ex: Child Dev, Principles of Engineering, Digital Electronics), 3rd year of Language Other than English.
- **Athletics and PE**
 - **Athletics is currently for the following sports;** golf, volleyball, baseball, softball, tennis, football, soccer, cross country, boys' basketball, field hockey. *Subject to change.
 - **If playing a sport that practices 6th period,** you **must** choose athletics. If playing a sport be sure to indicate the sport on the Elective Choice Google Form
 - **If you have not taken 2 years of PE, you must sign up for PE, PE Dance, AFJROTC or Marching Band/Color Guard in 11th or 12th grade.**
- **College Classes:** *Make sure you meet the prerequisites.* If attendance issues, (tardies and unverified absences or truancies) or citizenship issues, **DO NOT sign-up!** **Taking college classes, will begin your college transcript that transfers to your university.** You and a parent/guardian **must** watch the Community College presentation live on February 18 at 5:00 p.m. or the taped version. **You must also submit a Google Form with your Community College CSID by March 14.** Be aware, it may take up to 48 hours for the CSID to process. Plan accordingly! Please follow directions carefully!

Keep in mind your overall time commitments (sports, family responsibilities, work, community service, rigor of classes, etc.) when choosing classes for next

Remember...NO CHANGES after Kick-off
