ADVANCEMENT INFORMATION

All classes that are required for graduation must be fulfilled at Scripps Ranch High School, or by an approved summer course through our district. No other classes taken outside of SDUSD will be put on our transcript.

Students who wish to take a class for level advancement may do so on their own, knowing that it will not go on their transcript or fulfill a graduation requirement.

The two areas that students may opt for a level advancement are Math and Language Other Than English (LOTE).

BE AWARE OF THESE 3 ITEMS

Number 1

When signing up for classes with your counselor, you must sign up for the next class in progressive order. For example, if you are in Advanced Integrated Math 1, you must sign up for Integrated Math 2 or Advanced Integrated Math 2. If you choose to take Integrated Math 2 in the summer, you will need to show your counselor your official transcript from your summer program during kick off. If space is available, we will put you in the class that you are requesting at that time.

Number 2

You are still responsible for fulfilling the graduation requirements for math and/or LOTE. You will need six credits for math on your SRHS transcript and you must have at least a second year LOTE class on your high school transcript in order to fulfill these requirements.

Number 3

Please note that level advancement is not recommended by our Math department, our Language Other Than English (LOTE) department, or our counselors. Students will not be getting the same academic experience in six weeks as compared to a full year. Therefore, students who choose this option may not be as prepared or successful in the higher level math or LOTE classes if a strong foundation isn't developed through a summer program.

This is a very important point that we want to make sure you clearly understand before making any decisions. Please remember to talk to your counselor during articulation if you have any questions about these items.
