SHORTENED DAY

For the 2024-25 school year SRHS will allow SENIORS to have a shortened day if they meet the following criteria:

- Must have Minimum Cumulative Academic GPA of 2.75.
- Must have completed 36 credits for a 5 period day.
- Does not need to remediate any classes.
- Attempted and completed (or is currently enrolled in) at least one advanced studies course: college course, Advanced or Honors weighted courses, AP course, and/or CTE college articulated course during grades 9-12.
